General

- 1. Southern Airway's overall completion rate was 97.8% for July, with a controllable completion rate of 98.7%. Passenger loads remained relatively flat from June, but are up from July of 2015. The reports of completed flights, enplanements, and total passengers are included with this report.
- 2. We have provided additional justification to DOT for our decision to recommend the addition of the BWI hub to our EAS service. We have not received any indication from DOT when the bids will be awarded.
- 3. Our 5-year agreement with Delta Airport Consultants is expiring. We have received information from five firms in response to our RFQ. The selection committee will need to review these submissions and determine which of the applicants they wish to interview.

Marketing/Promotion

1. Planning is continuing for the Wings of Freedom visit August 19-21. We have learned that this year's visit by the Colling's Foundation will include four aircraft; a B-17 Flying Fortress, a B-24 Liberator, a B-25 Mitchell, and a P-51 Mustang. The Altoona Antique Auto Club and Corvette Club will have displays on Saturday of the event. The Greater Pennsylvania Military Preservation Association will host displays of military vehicles and weaponry on both Saturday and Sunday, as well as sponsor a hangar dance on Friday evening.

Property

- 1. Safe Q, LLC, began work on the FBO Fuel Farm repairs in the last week of July.
- 2. Flightway One, LLC, has not removed the DeGol Jet A Fuel system yet. They are currently completing the permitting process at the new location, and expect to have the system removed in 5-8 weeks. We will continue to coordinate the removal with the delivery of the new DeGol Aviation fuel system.
- 3. Atty. Pertile has prepared a lease agreement with Barbush Rentals Inc., the Avis franchise holder that owns the rights to the Avis operation at the airport, which is operated by AOO Kitty Hawk. This agreement will replace the current agreement with AOO Kitty Hawk. There is a motion on tonight's agenda to approve this new lease agreement.
- 4. AOO Kitty Hawk has requested an amendment to their lease allowing the restaurant to be closed on Mondays. I recommend that we also include in that amendment a requirement to provide service beginning at 8:00 AM on the days the restaurant is open (Tuesday Sunday). There is a motion on the agenda tonight to approve this lease amendment.
- 5. We need to get a lease agreement with Southern Airways now that they have taken over full operation from Sun Air. There is a motion on the agenda to assign the existing Sun Air Express lease to Southern Airways Express. There is no other change in the lease.

Personnel

- 1. Our new maintenance employee, Del Hoover, is doing well. He is scheduled for ARFF training at PIT in late September.
- 2. After evaluating purchase and rental options, Jeff Hill and I have determined that a purchase of uniforms is a much more economical way to proceed. Uniforms can be purchased for \$2,100, versus an annual rental fee of \$3,100.

Finance

1. Financial reports for the month of August are included. Invoices for August total \$37,082.38.
